To deliver quality vocational training, support, enable young people and adults to gain skills, qualifications and confidence to enhance their full potential for a positive future in life.

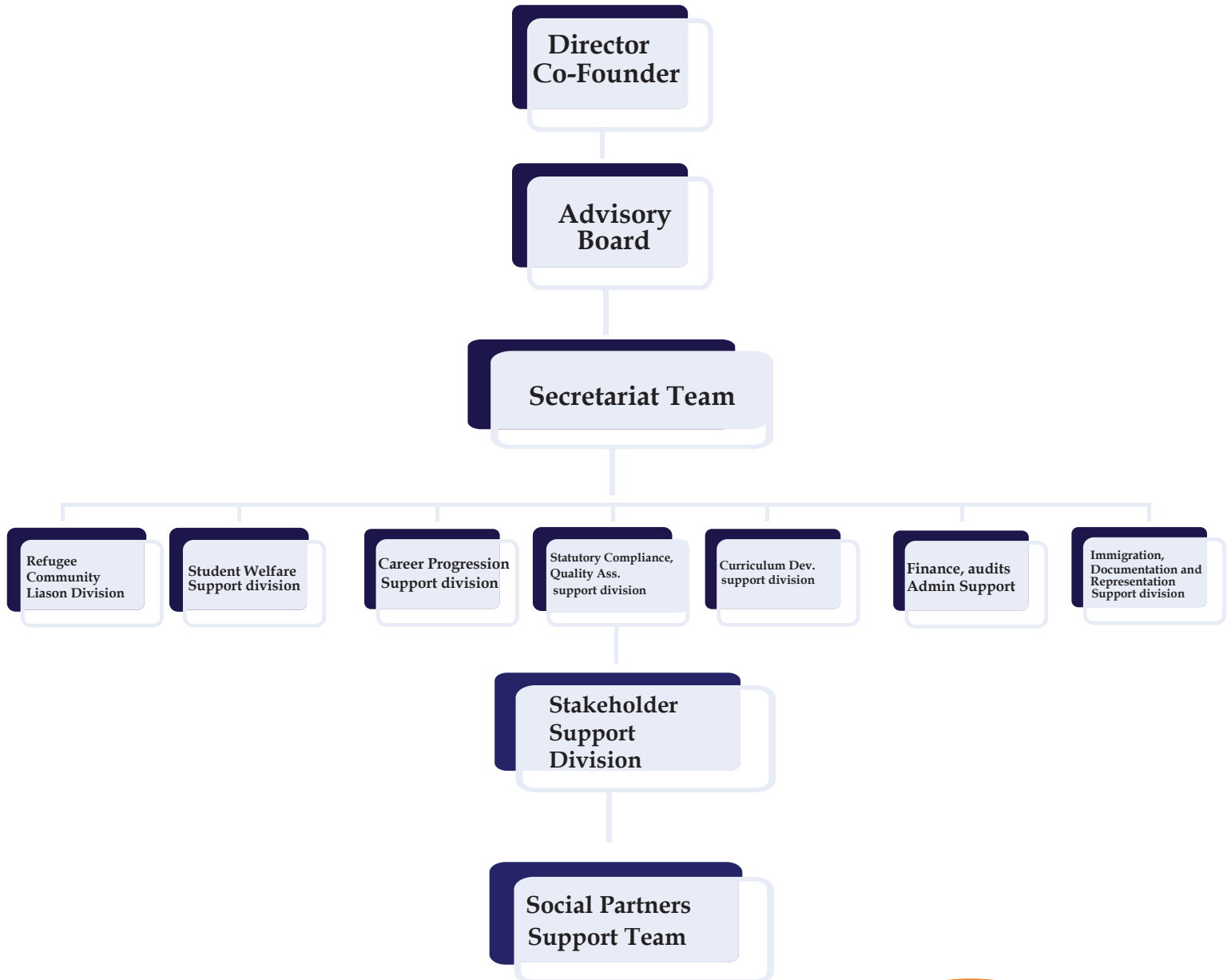
GOAL

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

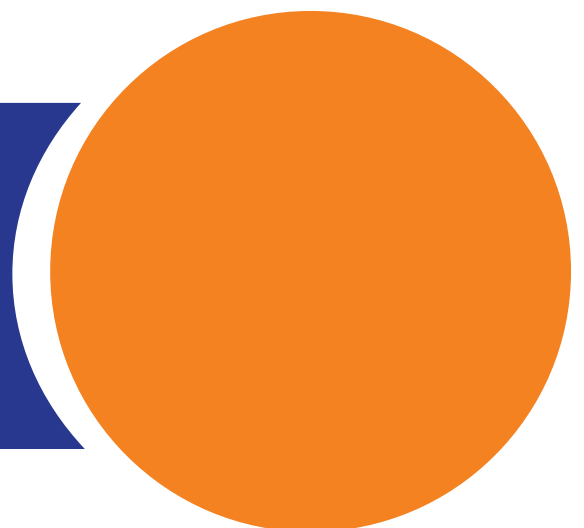
